A Silent Auction to benefit the American Sign Museum will be held at the Museum's booth at the International Sign Association show, April 7-10, 2010 in Orlando, FL.

- **Items needed.** *Once again, we are accepting consumer goods such as DVD players, iPods, etc. as well as products and/or services related to sign design, fabrication and/or installation. It is suggested that items have a minimum retail value of \$500.00. Gift certificates are also appropriate for both consumer goods as well as sign-related items. Donation should include shipping within the Continental U.S., except under special circumstances when donor stipulates otherwise.*
- **Donation description.** Each donated product or service will have a precise text description and photo if possible. Literature to supplement the description will be available in the booth for further review. "Value" amount will be stated, together with donating company's name.
- **Auction time schedule.** The auction will begin with the opening of the Exhibit Hall on Thursday, April 8 @ 10:00 am and continue throughout the show until Noon on Saturday, April 10.
- **Winning bids.** Auction participants may review list of winners after 1:00 pm on Saturday, April 10. Winners should make payment at the show by 5:00 pm on Saturday, April 10. Those who have not claimed their bid will be notified by mail, phone or e-mail by April 20 at which time payment arrangements must be made. Credit card payment is preferred. Donors will be notified to ship items (where appropriate) once payment is received.
- **Donor recognition.** All donating companies will be identified with a "We support the American Sign Museum" showcard, given out on Wednesday, April 7 for display in donors' booths, as well as a showcard directing visitors to the museum's booth. Donors will be recognized on the museum's website and in the Museum's monthly column in *Signs of the Times* magazine.
